

The FFSS Outreach

If your church is like most churches in America, several days or opportunities each year are planned to bring people from the community into the church for one day, or more, with the hope of leading them to Jesus Christ and membership in the congregation:

- Easter Sunday • Christmas • Mother's Day • Father's Day • Thanksgiving
- Vacation Bible School • Revivals • Special Events • Fall Festival • Etc.

On the single day opportunities, the Pastor has about an hour to reach inside the heart of the visitors and hopefully lead them towards salvation. Sadly, more times than not, the messages never reach the heart of the lost souls and they continue on their way lost and wandering in the wilderness. Other opportunities to lead them to salvation may occur, but if not, they will never have a chance for eternal life.

Some of the excuses that people use for not attending church:

- They think that Christians are hypocritical
- They claim they don't have proper clothes to wear
- They think that all the church wants is their money
- They don't like getting up early on Sunday morning
- Etc...

But it doesn't matter what excuses that the people around your community are using for not attending your church, the fact is, they are not coming, as you already know.

Example: A man needed to cut his grass but his lawn mower was wouldn't start, so he walked next door to borrow his neighbor's lawn mower. The neighbor informed him that he couldn't borrow the mower because they were having fried chicken for dinner. The man was totally confused and couldn't figure out what having fried chicken had to do with borrowing the lawn mower. He thought about it for a few minutes and went back and asked to borrow the mower again. Once more the neighbor said that he could not borrow the lawn mower because they were having fried chicken for dinner. Aggravated and confused, the man asked what them having fried chicken for dinner had to do with borrowing the lawn mower, the other man replied, "Nothing...but any old excuse will do".

What are some of the reasons why your church members are not out spreading the word of God? Why are they not witnessing and inviting their relatives, friends, and neighbor's to church?

- Do they feel like they don't know enough about the Bible?
- Are they are afraid someone will ask them a question about the Bible or Religion that they cannot answer?



- Do they think that their relatives, friends, and neighbors who know about the mistakes that they have made in the past and are fearful that they will be judged and asked, “what gives you the right to preach to us”?
- Are they aware that once they leave church on Sunday that they don’t live a Christian life throughout the week and never take the time to witness or invite other people to church to hear the word of God and the message of eternal life through Jesus Christ?

Once again, everyone is full of excuses. Whatever excuse is being used it is the reason that the church and congregation is not growing. The bottom line is, if a church is not growing, it is dying.

They have been oversold on the affordability of luxury they don’t need with credit they can’t afford. The temptations are everywhere. All of this mixed together has grave consequences. Family stress caused by money trouble is stealing their focus away from serving the kingdom of God and that is just the tip of the iceberg.
